CHEER, Inc. was founded in 1986 by the Starling-Wilburn families of Yazoo City, Mississippi. CHEER has provided children and adults across the world with the opportunity to increase their chances of having a more productive life by becoming more informed and better educated. Specifically, CHEER has distributed more than 18M (18,000,000) books to 78 countries (multiple times) at a cost of \$1B (1 billion dollars). These 78 countries represent 43% of the countries of the world.

CHEER has provided SES services to 20 school districts, and student achievement increased in each district. The CHEER program is research-based, and the instruction is aligned with The Mississippi Curriculum Framework.
