- 1. MORE Learning provides tutorial services in reading, language arts, and math for grades K to 8th.**
- 2. Our tutorials are normally provided afterschool on site at the selected school. Services are normally provides two to three sessions per week.**
- 3. Each session usually runs 1.5 to 2 hours. Up to 32 hours can be given to each student depending on the school district's allotment.**
- 4. MORE provides small group tutorials, with a student:teacher ratio ranging from 5:10 to 10:10.**
- 5. Every school that MORE has worked with that had 16 or more students in the past five years has made AYP. This includes schools that were in Needs Improvement for 6,8, and 10 years respectively.**
- 6. MORE has been a SES provider in Mississippi, Georgia, and Michigan for the past 5 years.**
- 7. MORE provides tutors that are certified in the areas that they tutor in. We also hire tutors who have collegiate credit hours in areas that they are tutoring as well.**
- 8. MORE provides services in reading, language arts, and math.**
- 9. MORE specializes in working with students with learning disabilities. We have instructional pacing guides to special in the needs of children with learning disabilities.**
- 10. MORE has a parental involvement coordinator that contacts parents through phone, email, and letters to inform them of student progress and announcements. The MORE state program coordinator submits documents to district on a monthly basis that gives an overview of student progress.**
